Hello,

Dirk asked us to provide some numbers. I want to preface this with, we do not have his final salary yet from Seward County, so we are using the current 2025 money with the first two quarters annualized. These could change.

The current FAS is \$73,578.66. If we retire him with 26 YOS (14@ 1.75% and 12@ 1.85%) his max is estimated at \$2863.44. He has chosen the 50% J/A benefit, which would reduce this to \$2,605.73 with the spouse's portion at \$1,302.87.

If he stays with his service as is, using the same FAS. He would have 20 years of KPF @ 2.5% - max is estimated at \$3,065.78, the J/A reduction would be \$2,897.16, and the spouse's portion \$1,448.58. In addition, he would still have 6 years KPERS @ 1.75%, max benefit estimated at \$643.81. With the J/A

The combined benefits with the monthly option he has currently would have given him a gross benefit of \$3,483.03. With only KPERS service, his gross would be only \$2,605.73.

Lisa mentioned that B&MS does not have the ability to modify KITS to move forward with this change, however Fiscal Services can make the change in KITS. Lisa mentioned that Lanette might be a good resource to get this change made.

Laurie,

I'm also working with Lisa and Ciera to gather the income estimates tied to each scenario. I should have that to you later today or tomorrow at the latest.

We'll stand by until we get word from FS that Mr. Standard's details have been updated from a portability scenario to a pure KPERS retirement application. Once that is done, we can move forward with his July 1 retirement application.
